GPA: 3.0 Required, 3.5 Recommended
Good Citizenship & Dedication to the Team
Two Qualifying Times (800m, 1600m, 3200m, 2mi, 3mi, 5km, Steeplechase)
Attendance at the Annual Mammoth Camp
Community Service/Volunteer: 10 hours of service
Fundraising: 100 Required, 300 Recommended

Each athlete has worked hard to attain or work towards the above goals and have displayed themselves as not only good athletes, but as good students and citizens as well and it is an honor for each of these athletes to receive an invitation to this meet.

One of the largest obstacles of many of the athletes tends to be the sixth qualifying mark of fundraising. Although meeting the first five standards is quite an accomplishment, the students must also find a way to earn their trip by receiving outside support through fundraisers and sponsorships. With the trip costing upwards in the range of \$18,000 for the athletes and chaperones, our goal has been to raise at least 60% (\$10,800) of that amount if not the full amount.
