From September 16-20, 2010, the Cerritos High School Country team will travel to Honolulu, Hawaii to compete at the Iolani Invitational. In order to qualify for the meet, each Don needs to meet certain criteria:

GPA: 3.0 Required, 3.5 Recommended

Good Citizenship & Dedication to the Team

Two Qualifying Times (800m, 1600m, 3200m, 2mi, 3mi, 5km)

Attendance at the Annual Mammoth Camp

Fundraising: 300 Required, 500 Recommended

Enrolled in Cerritos Cross Country & Track & Field

If you are receiving this letter, you have reached, have come close to reaching, or are expected to have an opportunity to reach the goals described in the requirements, thus, the process for preparing for the trip begins.

One of the largest obstacles of many of the athletes tends to be the fifth qualifying mark of fundraising. Although meeting the first four standards is quite an accomplishment, the students must also find a way to earn their trip by receiving outside support through fundraisers and sponsorships. With the trip costing upwards in the range of \$15,000 for the athletes and chaperones, our goal has been to raise at least 60% (\$9,000) of that amount if not the full amount (\$300-\$500/athlete).

We appreciate the efforts put forth and hope that you begin the process of fundraising for this potential trip. Support for sponsors and companies can come through direct sponsorships, purchasing advertisements in our end of the year program, sponsoring a banner to hang at all of our meet or by including a logo on our team shirts, worn by over two hundred individuals! All of the funds that you raise will be directed to your account, thus, even if you end up not qualifying or declining your invitation, you will be able to use your funds as you see fit!
